

SARVAC HWF P/T Association Level Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) Phase 7 - TASKING



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PURPOSE: The purpose of this document is to provide a P/T Association level SOP for the *TASKING Phase* of SARVAC's HWF Program.

SUMMARY: The *TASKING Phase* takes place now that the HWF Responders have arrived in the Jurisdiction that has made the request for assistance. They will report to the AHJ where they will be assimilated into the Incident organizational structure and assigned taskings.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. P/T Associations should remain aware of the activities being done by their participating HWF Responders during Taskings.
- 2. P/T Associations should be aware that the RC provides Daily Status reports to the NIST DIR (or OSM when assigned) regarding the deployment progress. The NIST should, in turn, provide situational summaries to P/T Associations, as well as other stakeholders.

Daily Status reports should include but are not limited to:

- Number of deployed personnel, as well as any released.
- Tasking descriptions and progress reporting.
- Safety incidents and/or concerns.
- Medical Aids and/or intervention occurrences.
- Weather/Environmental/Structural events.
- National Relief efforts, numbers of partner/local relief resources.
- Documented and/or anticipated issues.

3. P/T Associations should be aware that CISM resources are available for participating HWF Responders.

P/T associations should be aware that some HWF Responders may have been exposed to situations where CISM resources could benefit them. P/T Associations should refer to the CISM guidance document. CISM resources may also be provided by the P/T Association's own CISM Program.

This completes the TASKING Phase in accordance with the National Search and Rescue Operations Concept.
